The Year 5 children came back to school in two separate 'bubbles' to undertake a two-day art and design project based on the book, The Colour Monster.



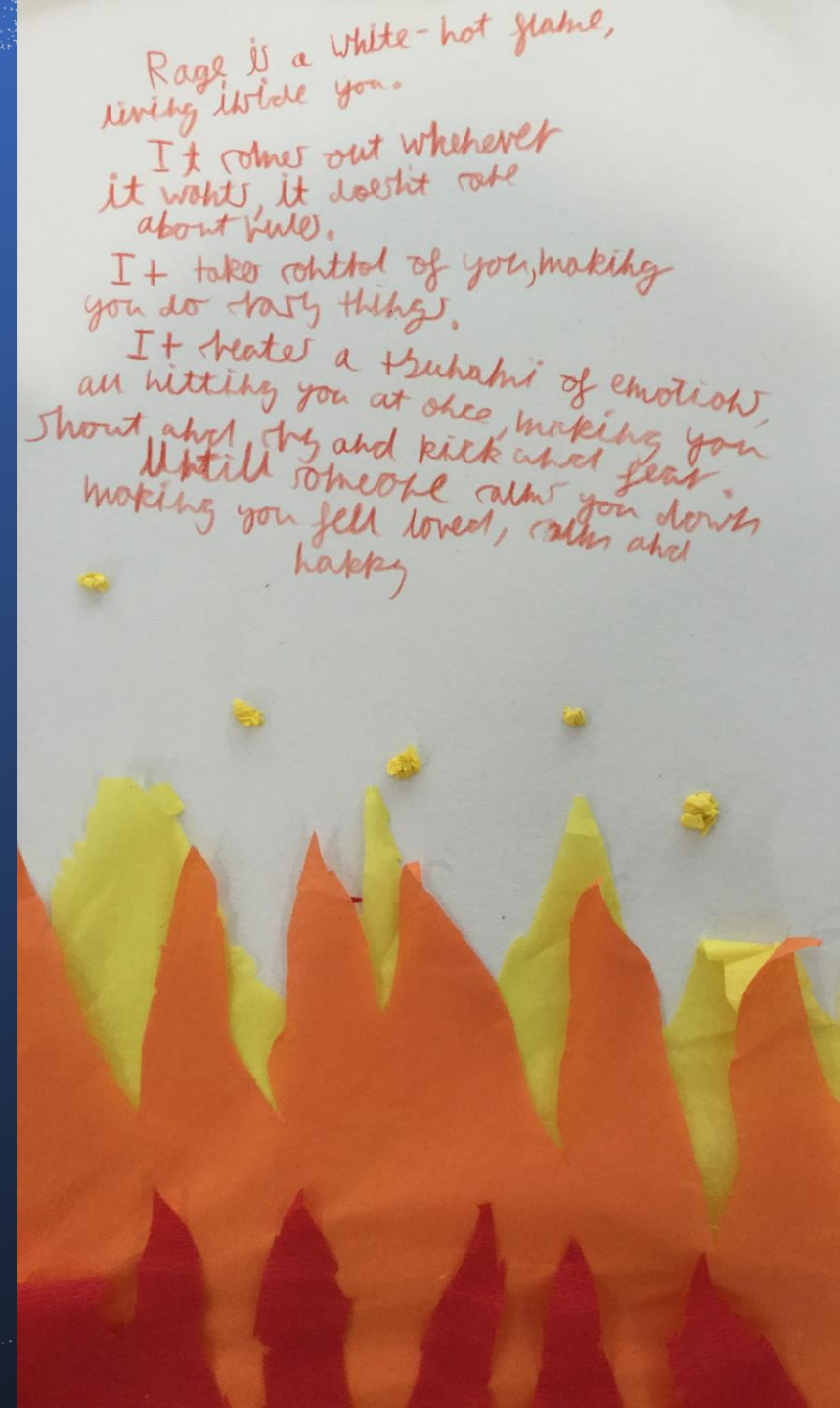


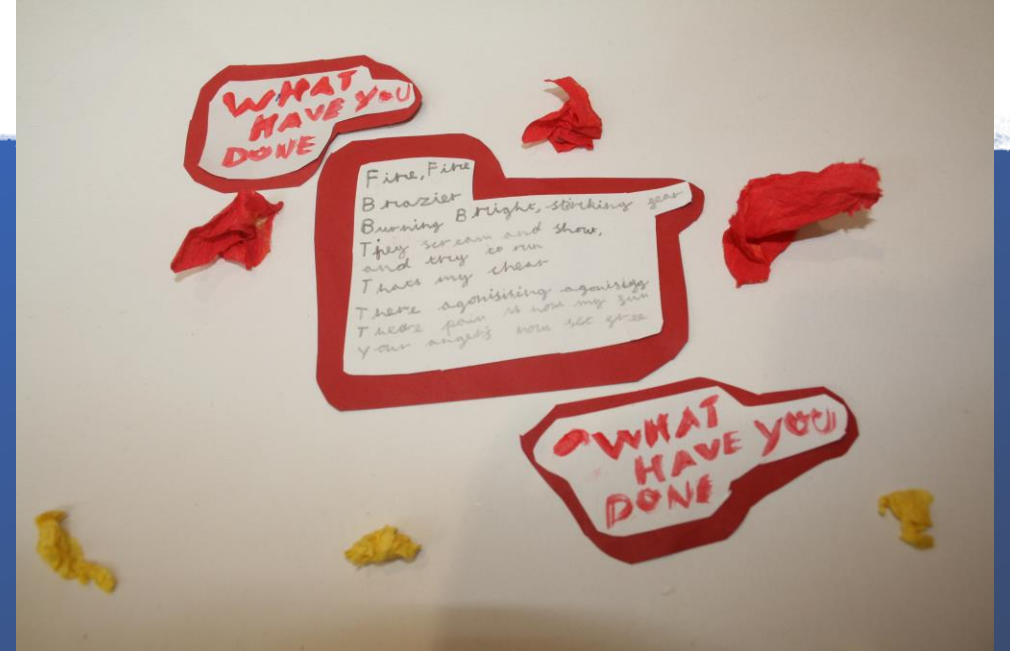
